## **STRUGGLING WITH PROPERTY TAXES?** **THERE IS HELP!**

- **If you are behind on your taxes, you may be at risk of losing your home in foreclosure.** Homeowners struggling to pay their taxes need to learn about possible options to avoid the loss of their home.
- If you need help with your taxes, contact these agencies to see if you qualify for financial assistance:
  - **Community Action Agency (CAA)** – Funds available to help homeowners with delinquent property tax payments because of a COVID -19 hardship. Income restriction. To check eligibility, call 513-569-1840 or visit [cincy-caa.org](http://cincy-caa.org).
  - **Working in Neighborhoods** – Funds available to help homeowners in Roselawn and Bond Hill. To check eligibility, call 513-541-4109.
  - **Legal Aid Society** – Up to \$3,000 payment available for homeowners in the City of Cincinnati. Income restriction. Legal Aid can also help homeowners complete applications for CAA funds. To check eligibility, call 513-241-9400.
