The LRS requires attorneys to meet specifications for each area of law in which they receive referrals and require attorneys maintain professional liability insurance. The LRS Modest Means Program will not cover all areas of the law. Since there is such a wide span between market rate for attorneys and the rates charged by Legal Aid and Public Defenders, we're hoping to provide services for those individuals who would not normally be able to afford legal representation.


